

And, additional meaningful suggestions:


- Align expectations: Tell us what/when to expect.
- Give us ways to find contacts, resources, and items you require us to complete.
- Provide unified responses to requirements.
- Increase [our] ability to prepare and negotiate budget.
- We advocate for improved feasibility assessment and need help.
- Provide more support, especially for researchers and study coordinators new to our process.
- Are we an overly risk adverse institution?

Learning from peer institutions






Increasing quality of the submission – current focus:

Data points - in process, lots of details & good work



Three important metrics

- 1. Work-in-process
- 2. Time to complete the study start-up
- 3. Satisfaction

Managing work-in-process will lead to on-time delivery, which in turn will lead to higher enrollment rate and ultimately increased satisfaction.


Time: entire start-up, using Expedited




Time: entire start-up, using Full Board
